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### HON. SECRETARY'S ANNUAL REPORT 2018-2019

Twelve monthly meetings were held by the Executive Committee ("ExCo") from 9 October 2018 to 10 September 2019. Under the able leadership of President Dr. Evelyn Y. F. MAN and her team, including Vice-Presidents Ms. Lucy T. P. CHEUNG and Ms. Catherine Y. L. CHEUNG, Hon. Treasurer Mr. Danny F. L. LI, Hon. Secretary Ms. Agnes P. T. CHEUNG, together with other ExCo and Sub-Committee Members, the Association witnessed continued growth and development.

It has been an active year for the Association with some 50 events being organised, covering a variety of activities including social networking, recreational, educational, community services and dining events, as well as choir performances. Convenors of all Sub-Committees submitted written and/or verbal monthly reports at every ExCo meeting. Thanks go to all ExCo and Sub-Committee Members who contributed to make the past year a great success.

Operations Officers Mr. Michael CHOW, Mr. Sunny IP (resigned in February 2019) and Ms. Natalie WONG (promoted to Operations Manager in July 2019) continued to work alongside administration staff Ms. CHENG Yee-fong and Clubhouse Manager Mr. LAU Chi-on to ensure smooth day-to-day operation of the Association.

### 2. The House and Bar Sub-Committee (Convenor: Mr. Thomas M. T. TSO)

- Upon the expiration of the two-year catering contract with Stand Great Investment Limited ("Stand Great"), a new three-year contract was signed on 9 October 2018.
   Regular meetings were held with Stand Great, with a view to improving food quality, menu variety, services and Clubhouse facilities.
- ii. The food and beverage sales remained stable overall during the period, although revenue decreased due to increased competition from other dining outlets newly opened in the neighbourhood, a general downturn in the economy and social unrest in recent months. However, the restaurant still enjoyed good reputation for serving quality food, and innovative seasonal dishes were introduced to attract more customers. The restaurant and the AA Bar remained financially sound and healthy in the year under review.
- iii. The Clubhouse would undergo an overall renovation. Preparatory work was underway and the actual work would be carried out in the second quarter of 2020, with exact dates to be announced later. The project would be supervised by architect Mr. Tommy LING, Chairman of the Bar Committee, with the assistance of designer Mr. Alvin LEE of MELT. Stand Great had agreed to shoulder part of the renovation costs. A donor had also been found to subsidise part of the renovation cost,
- iv. An ad-hoc committee chaired by Mr. Jeffrey SHAM had been set up to update the menu of the Restaurant both in design and content. It was hoped that a new menu would be available by the time the renovation project had been completed.

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#### 3. The Social and Events Sub-Committee (Convenor: Mr. Alex C. H. LAI)

- i. In the past year, three hiking activities were organised:
  - 10/11/2018 Pineapple Dam Lung Mun Country Trail Chuen Lung (with 39 participants)
  - 27/01/2019 A Trip to Lion Rock and Amah Rock (獅子山望夫石之旅) (coorganised with HKU Old Halls Alumni Association) (with 60 participants)
  - 17/03/2019 A Trip to Cape D'Aguilar (春季鶴咀之旅) (co-organised with HKU Engineering Alumni Association) (with 110 participants)

The objectives of the aforementioned activities were to provide healthy outdoor events for members, let them get in touch with nature and provide a platform for them to make and meet friends. The trails chosen were easy and the participants enjoyed the hikes very much.

- ii. HKUAA BBQ Dinner at Aberdeen Boat Club was held on 23/11/2018 with 41 participants. Participants generally found the evening enjoyable. Thanks go to alumnus Mr. John WAN for booking the venue.
- iii. The HKUAA Buffet Dinner at the Hong Kong Club was held on 19/01/2019. 108 members and guests participated and they generally found the food and atmosphere very enjoyable. Thanks go to Mr. Kenneth SIT for reserving the venue and selecting a high quality menu. This event has been organised every year since 2011 and has proven to be very popular.

#### 4. The HKUAA Choir Sub-Committee (Convenor: Ms. Lucy T. P. CHEUNG)

- i. The Choir gave three performances during the 2018 Christmas season:

- iii. For the Summer Season, the Choir hosted "Let's Go Musical III" on 14/07/2019 at the China Congregational Church in Causeway Bay, featuring songs from the popular musical *Phantom of the Opera* and individual ensembles.

#### 5. The University Liaison Sub-Committee (Convenor: Mr. TSE Sik-yan)

i. Close ties with the University were maintained through the presence of Ms. Janet CHUNG of DAAO, who often briefed us on the latest development of HKU, at the ExCo meetings.

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- ii. Many ExCo Members were present at the HKU Reunion at the Races, which was held at the Shatin Racecourse on 02/06/2019, during which the HKUAA Challenge Cup was presented.
- iii. President and V.C. Professor Xiang Zhang and members of the Senior Management Team and some Hon. VPs attended a dinner after the New Graduates Welcome Party on 03/11/2018, the first time the President visited HKUAA and had a meal there.
- iv. HKUAA encouraged members to be an iGifter and assist in the donation to the Rosie YOUNG scarf by making donation forms and the scarf easily available at the Clubhouse.

### 6. The Membership Sub-Committee (Convenor: Dr. William W. T. YIP)

- i. The Association enjoyed further growth in membership number. As at early September 2019, membership registered a 3.3% increase (an addition of 1,123 members) compared to a year ago, reaching a total of 35,563 members, with quite a number joining as Life Members, apart from being Ordinary Members.
- ii. A continuous membership drive was underway to strengthen the bonding amongst alumni members.
- iii. A committee chaired by Ms. Catherine Y. L. CHEUNG was set up in July 2019 to review and identify collaboration opportunities with external bodies to enhance membership benefits.

### 7. The PR and Communications Sub-Committee (Convenor: Ms. Kitty K. L. TSE)

i. Two Trial Chinese Wellness Dinners were held on 10/04/2019 and 26/04/2019 with Traditional Chinese Medicine experts Dr. Abby YANG and Miss Ashley TO as speakers, with a view to identifying potential dishes to be added to our menu.
