HON. SECRETARY'S ANNUAL REPORT 2020-2021

1. Overview

Twelve monthly meetings were held by the Executive Committee ("ExCo") from 13 October 2020 to 7 September 2021. Under the able leadership of President Dr. Evelyn Y. F. MAN and her team, including Vice-Presidents Ms. Catherine Y. L. CHEUNG and Mr. Vincent W. S. WONG, Hon. Treasurer Mr. Danny F. L. LI, Hon. Secretary Ms. Agnes P. T. CHEUNG, together with other ExCo and Sub-Committee Members, the Association witnessed continued growth and development.

After a year of the COVID-19 pandemic, there was a rapid shift towards virtual event delivery. The Association, too, had embraced this trend. In the past year, a wide variety of webinars were held to enrich Members' knowledge and understanding on different topics, and most of the ExCo meetings were held via video conferencing or in hybrid mode, in compliance with the Government's social distancing regulations. Despite the difficulties faced, the Lounge area was successfully renovated in mid-2021. ExCo Members were actively involved in the project in different capacities and it was very much a team effort. Convenors of all Sub-Committees also submitted written and/or verbal monthly reports at every ExCo meeting. Details and photos of the activities held could be found on <u>www.hkuaa.org.hk</u>. Operations Manager Ms. Natalie WONG (resigned in December 2020) and Operations Officer Mr. Michael CHOW continued to work alongside administration staff Ms. CHENG Yee-fong and Clubhouse Manager Mr. LAU Chi-on to ensure smooth day-to-day operation of the Association.

2. House and Bar Sub-Committee (Convenor: Mr. Vincent W. S. WONG)

- i. Regular meetings were held with the caterer, Stand Great Investment Limited, with a view to improving food quality, menu variety, services and Clubhouse facilities.
- ii. Business was slowly picking up amid the ongoing pandemic. Various measures were taken during the past year to sustain operations and to comply with the Government's regulations in a timely manner. To seize the opportunity arising from the Consumption Voucher Scheme, a gadget was procured to accept all four kinds of payment methods under the Scheme. Air purifiers were purchased and installed in the light of the air change requirements for restaurants. The staff vaccination campaign was making good progress. The Sub-Committee was working to have the Clubhouse operate under "Type C" mode as soon as possible.
- iii. The Bar was to be officially called the Lounge in order to avoid confusion with "bar" as defined by the Law, which was subject to different statutory regulations. The Lounge underwent renovation from April to June 2021 and was henceforth renamed

DB Lounge as specified by the donor Ms. Beatrice MOK. An opening ceremony would be held after putting up a commemorative plaque in recognition of Ms. MOK's generous donation. The work was supervised by volunteer architect Mr. Tommy LING. Ms. Kitty TSE and Mr. Jeffrey SHAM had also designed a snack menu. An air fryer was purchased for preparing snacks at the Lounge. Thanks go to Ms. Beatrice MOK for her donation towards the renovation project and coffee beans from Thailand, as well as Dr. Edward C. H. LEONG for his coffee machine.

- iv. Ms. Kitty TSE had also kindly donated an automated external defibrillator ("AED") to the Clubhouse. A training session was arranged and a few senior restaurant staff attended. The AED would be stored in the Manager's Room.
- v. In order to reduce clutter in the 8/F Office, some of the old utensils were up for sale. An order form had been uploaded to the Association's website.

3. Social and Events Sub-Committee (Convenor: Mr. Alex C. H. LAI)

- i. "HKUAA BBQ Dinner at Aberdeen Boat Club" was held on 23/07/2021 with 20 paid registrants (full house). Eventually, 19 people attended the Dinner and found the evening highly enjoyable.
- ii. HKUAA Dinner Talk "把挑戰變成一種習慣" by mountaineer Ms. Ada TSANG was held at the Clubhouse on 08/09/2021 with simultaneous Zoom broadcast. Ms. TSANG summited Mount Everest in 2017, the first woman from Hong Kong to achieve such a feat. She went on setting the world record for the fastest ascent of Mount Everest by a woman in 25 hours and 50 minutes in 2021. She shared her journey during the Talk and the participants found it most informative and inspiring.
- iii. "Countries in Pictures Travel Talk Series" was held between August and September 2021. Four lunch talks were delivered by Mr. Vincent WONG at the Clubhouse on 07/08/2021(Iraq), 14/08/2021(Iraq), 18/09/2021(Iran) and 25/09/2021(Iran) respectively.

4. HKUAA Choir Sub-Committee (Convenor: Ms. Lucy T. P. CHEUNG)

Rehearsals of the Fall Season started on 11/09/2021. A matinee show was scheduled to be held at the China Congregational Church on 28/11/2021 with free admission.

5. University Liaison Sub-Committee (Convenor: Mr. TSE Sik-yan)

Close ties with the University were maintained through the presence of Ms. Janet CHUNG of DAAO, who often briefed us on the latest development of HKU at the ExCo meetings.
