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HON. SECRETARY'S ANNUAL REPORT 2022-2023

1. Overview

Twelve monthly meetings were held by the Executive Committee ("ExCo") from 11 October 2022 to 12 September 2023. Under the able leadership of President Ms. Catherine Y. L. CHEUNG and her team, including Vice-Presidents Mr. Vincent W. S. WONG and Ms. Kitty K. L. TSE, Hon. Treasurer Mr. Danny F. L. LI, Hon. Secretary Ms. Agnes P. T. CHEUNG, together with other ExCo and Sub-Committee Members, the Association continued to witness steady growth and development.

During the year, the pandemic began to subside. Daily life and activities were getting back to normal. As a leading alumni body with over 40,000 members, the Association continued to provide a meeting place and a diverse range of activities to enrich members' social life, expand alumni linkage and create inspirations. With the relaxation of social distancing requirements, 2022-2023 was an active year for the Association with almost 50 events being organised, ranging from lunch/dinner talks, guided tours, webinars to choir performances. All of the ExCo meetings were held in hybrid mode. Convenors of all Sub-Committees submitted written and/or verbal monthly reports at every ExCo meeting. Operations Manager Mr. Thomas LEUNG (resigned in April 2023), Operations Officers Mr. Adrian LAU (resigned in January 2023), Ms. Vicky ZHENG and Ms. Alisa CHUNG (part-time) worked alongside administration staff Ms. CHENG Yee-fong, Ms. Minda LAU and Clubhouse Manager Mr. LAU Chi-on to ensure smooth day-to-day operation of the Association.

2. House and Bar Sub-Committee (Convenor: Mr. Vincent W. S. WONG)

- i. Regular meetings were held with the caterer, Stand Great Investment Limited, with a view to improving food quality, menu variety, services and Clubhouse facilities.
- ii. Food and beverage sales remained generally stable in the year under review. With removal of all public gathering restrictions, business had returned to pre-pandemic levels. Various measures were taken in a timely manner to enhance operations while complying with Government regulations, e.g. replacing all restaurant chairs to meet new safety standards, upgrading the fire safety system, improving ventilation and cleanliness of the Clubhouse, etc.
- iii. Mr. Joseph CHONG, our representative on the Incorporated Owners of Yip Fung Building ("IO"), continued to maintain close liaison with the IO to ensure Government regulations were met and improvements done to some facilities in the building.



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3. Social and Events Sub-Committee (Convenor: Mr. Alex C. H. LAI)

- i. "HKUAA Hiking 茅坪榼藤、北港、竹林隧道" was held on 12 February 2023 with Mr. KWAN Sek-yiu as the leader. It was a relaxing 3-hour hike with 74 participants.
- ii. "HKUAA Alumni Nite 2023" was held on 25 March 2023 at Chater Room, Hong Kong Jockey Club Happy Valley Clubhouse. An organising committee headed by Ms. Stella LAW was formed to plan and oversee the project. President and Vice-Chancellor Prof. Xiang ZHANG was invited to give a speech about the future development of HKU during dinner. It was a full-house event with 192 participants, who all found the evening very enjoyable. A total of 24 sponsors were recruited to contribute 27 lucky draw prizes and 12 table prizes.
- iii. "HKUAA BBQ Dinner at Aberdeen Boat Club" was held on 14 April 2023 with a full-house of 50 participants. The feedback received was highly positive.
- iv. "HKUAA Exclusive Music Talk and Lunch" was held on 27 May 2023 at the Clubhouse with Mrs. Mandy CHAN as the speaker.

4. HKUAA Choir Sub-Committee (Convenor: Ms. Lucy T. P. CHEUNG)

- i. Regarding the 2022 Fall Season, a full-house concert was held at the Chinese Congregational Church on 17 December 2022. The Choir also performed at the 1881 Heritage on 18 December 2022 in support of the Child Development Matching Fund.
- ii. During the 2023 Spring Season, the Choir performed Beethoven's Symphony No.9 in the SAR Philharmonic Orchestra's fund-raising concert on 30 April 2023 at the Hong Kong Cultural Centre. The Choir also performed two songs at the Alumni Nite.
- iii. As for the 2023 Summer Season, a matinee show featuring performances by an a cappella group, duets, ensembles and the whole Choir was staged at the Clubhouse on 24 June 2023, illustrating the diversity of musical talents among Choir members.

5. University Liaison Sub-Committee (Convenor: Mr. TSE Sik-yan)

Close ties with the University were maintained through the presence of Ms. Janet CHUNG of DAAO, who often briefed us on the latest developments of HKU at the ExCo meetings, including admission, policies, visiting scholars, special events and so on.



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6. Membership Sub-Committee (Convenor: Dr. William W. T. YIP)

- i. The Association enjoyed further growth in membership numbers. As at early September 2023, membership registered a 4.15% increase (an addition of 1,608 members) compared with that a year ago, reaching a total of 40,335 members, with quite a number joining as Life Members, apart from being Ordinary Members.
- ii. A continuous membership drive was underway to strengthen the bonding among members.

7. PR and Communications Sub-Committee (Convenor: Mr. Jeffrey C. F. SHAM)

- i. The Association's social media pages were constantly updated to promote our events.
- ii. "HKUAA Sake Tasting Workshop" by Dr. Halton HO was held at the DB Lounge on 25 November 2022. "HKUAA Visit to Heroes Beer Factory and Free Flow Event" was held on 26 August 2023. Both events received very positive feedback.

There was continuous effort to maintain and upgrade the digital and hardware infrastructure of the Association to enhance the experience of members at different online touch points as well as in the Clubhouse.
