HON. SECRETARY'S ANNUAL REPORT 2023-2024

1. Overview

Twelve monthly meetings were held by the Executive Committee ("ExCo") from 10 October 2023 to 10 September 2024. Under the able leadership of President Ms. Catherine Y. L. CHEUNG and her team, including Vice-Presidents Mr. Vincent W. S. WONG and Mr. Jeffrey C. F. SHAM, Hon. Treasurer Mr. Paul W. C. HO, Hon. Secretary Ms. Agnes P. T. CHEUNG, together with other ExCo and Sub-Committee Members, the Association continued to witness steady growth and development.

As a leading alumni body with over 40,000 members, the Association remained committed to offering a diverse range of experiences to members across different age groups and backgrounds during the year. Our Clubhouse in Central continued to serve as a popular meeting place for HKU alumni and friends. 2023-2024 was again an active year for the Association with some 50 events being organised, ranging from lunch and dinner talks, guided tours, workshops to choir performances. All of the ExCo meetings were held in hybrid mode. Convenors of all Sub-Committees submitted written and/or verbal monthly reports at every ExCo meeting. Thanks go to all ExCo and Sub-Committee Members who contributed to make the past year a great success.

Operations Officer Ms. Vicky ZHENG, part-time Operations Officer Ms. Alisa CHUNG (resigned in June 2024) and intern Ms. Jessie TAM worked alongside administration staff Ms. CHENG Yee-fong, Ms. Minda LAU and Clubhouse Manager Mr. LAU Chi-on (resigned in October 2023) to ensure smooth day-to-day operation of the Association.

2. House and Bar Sub-Committee (Convenor: Mr. Vincent W. S. WONG)

- i. On 9 December 2023, the Association reached an agreement to co-operate with Drawing Room Concepts ("DRC") to operate our Clubhouse. This change not only enabled us to upgrade the quality of food but also the ambiance as well as our service standard. New social media pages were introduced to enhance communication with members. Our revamped menu in the Chinese restaurant and enhanced offerings at the DB Lounge had been well received. Our goal was to create attractive experiences that encouraged members to return. The refurbished Clubhouse had indeed attracted members to host more corporate events, private gatherings, and even wedding banquets.
- ii. Over the past months, the Clubhouse had launched a wine dinner, introduced four seasonal menus, and extended its dim sum offerings at weekends. We were excited to announce our first-ever guest chef dinner in September 2024. Our new initiatives also included our brand-name Chinese New Year pudding and mooncakes.

iii. Mr. Joseph CHONG, our representative on the Incorporated Owners of Yip Fung Building ("IO"), continued to maintain close liaison with the IO to ensure Government regulations were met and improvements done to some facilities in the building.

3. Social and Events Sub-Committee (Convenor: Mr. Alex C. H. LAI)

- i. "HKUAA Buffet Dinner at The Hong Kong Club" was held on 13 January 2024 with 105 participants. The feedback received was overwhelmingly positive.
- ii. "HKUAA Music Talk and Lunch" was held at the Clubhouse on 1 June 2024 with Mrs. Mandy CHAN as the speaker.
- iii. "HKUAA Gourmet Dinner" was held at the Clubhouse on 27 July 2024 with 32 participants, of whom 16 were Life Members. We enjoyed the food and company.
- iv. "HKUAA BBQ Dinner at Aberdeen Boat Club" was held on 20 September 2024 with 41 participants. The atmosphere was great in spite of the drizzle. The participants could meet new and old friends and enjoyed the event very much.

4. HKUAA Choir Sub-Committee (Convenor: Ms. Lucy T. P. CHEUNG)

- i. During the 2023 Fall Season, the Choir performed in two concerts with the SAR Philharmonic Orchestra on 29 October and 4 November 2023 respectively. The Choir also participated in the 2023 Hong Kong Hymnos Festival on 20 November 2023. The season culminated in the Choir's 10th Anniversary Celebration Concert held on 29 December 2023 at the Methodist International Church, featuring 95 performers on stage.
- ii. The 2024 Spring Season commenced on 17 February 2024 following successful recruitment efforts. A highlight of this season was the matinee show featuring classic movie theme songs which took place on 28 April 2024 at the China Congregational Church.
- iii. Shortly after the Spring Season concluded, a vocal workshop led by Mr. Dennis LAU was held in June 2024, designed to help Choir members enhance their vocal techniques. This workshop successfully attracted 37 participants.

5. University Liaison Sub-Committee (Convenor: Mr. TSE Sik-yan)

Close ties with the University were maintained through the presence of Ms. Janet CHUNG of DAAO, who often briefed us on the latest developments of the University at the ExCo meetings, including admission, policies, visiting scholars, special events and so on.

6. Membership Sub-Committee (Convenor: Dr. William W. T. YIP)

- i. The Association enjoyed further growth in membership numbers. As at early September 2024, membership registered a 6.22% increase (an addition of 2,510 members) compared with that a year ago, reaching a total of 42,845 members, with quite a number joining as Life Members, apart from being Ordinary Members.
- ii. In order to diversify the income sources of the Association and address the rising administration costs, with effect from 1 January 2025, the Entrance Fees for Life Membership and Associate Life Membership would be increased from \$9,000 to \$15,000 and from \$18,000 to \$25,000 respectively.
- iii. A continuous membership drive was underway to strengthen the bonding among members.

7. PR and Communications Sub-Committee (Convenor: Ms. Kitty K. L. TSE)

- i. The Association's social media pages were constantly updated to promote our events.
- ii. A workshop on Chinese calendar and zodiac (公曆與十二生肖農曆算法) for children aged between three and eight was held at the DB Lounge over two sessions on 30 and 31 July 2024 respectively.

8. Technology and Operations Sub-Committee (Convenor: Mr. David Y. K. YIP)

Continuous efforts were made to maintain and upgrade the digital and hardware infrastructure of the Association to enhance the experience of members at different online touch points as well as in the Clubhouse. In addition, a brand-new e-membership card programme was rolled out to facilitate membership registration and management.

9. Golf Interest Group Sub-Committee (Convenor: Dr. Dicky LAM)

i. The Sub-Committee was re-formed with Ms. Carmen KAN and Mr. Wilson LEE as Co-Captains, supported by four Vice-Captains, one Undergraduate Representative, and four Advisory Members. Over the past year, the Sub-Committee successfully organised golf events on 17 November, 10 December 2023, 6 January, 13 January, 17 January, 14 July and 10 August 2024 respectively, in addition to a two-day trip to Zhongshan from 24 to 25 February 2024.
