Description

在馬鞍山郊遊徑上山，不久便到達昂坪。被高山環抱的昂坪，設有露營地點及燒烤設施，是本港少有的高山平原。此處曾是繁盛的山村，接有廣闊的田野。在此遠眺西貢海一帶景色，令人心曠神怡；這裏更是罕見的「看不到市區」的高地，此乃昂坪高原最迷人之處。Keeping to the country trail, you soon arrive at Ngong Ping. Embraced by towering spurs, this picturesque spot offers a campsite and barbecue facilities. Ngong Ping is one of Hong Kong's few plateaus. Once the site of a large village, it has paddy fields on the fringes. There are wide open views of the coves and islands of Inner Port Shelter. Another unique feature of Ngong Ping is that it is one of the very few high points where the urban districts are totally out of sight. A rare quality indeed in a city as compact as Hong Kong.

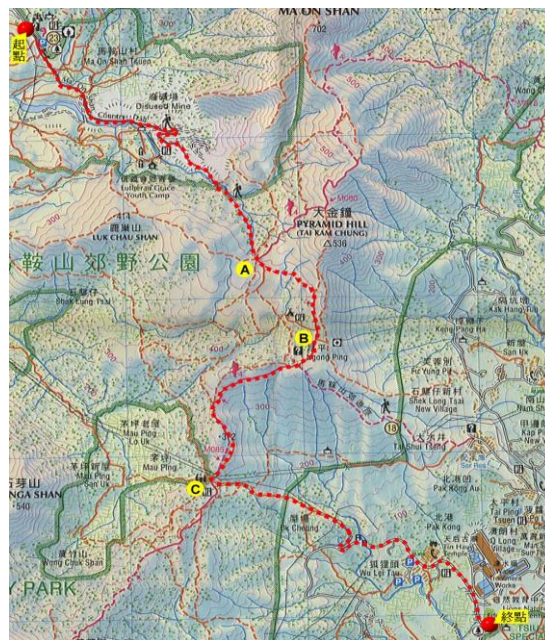
Bus：馬鞍山鐵路站乘85M, 86K, 86S, 87D, 87K, N281, N680號巴士到錦英苑
