Description

昂坪棧道為昂坪360的救援徑，連接了東涌至昂坪多個熱門大嶼山旅遊點。熱愛行山遠足等陸地活動人士，可沿著纜道下蜿蜒漫長的昂坪棧道親身享受青蔥翠綠，以最近的距離，在纜車相伴下接觸大自然。遊客可在參觀天壇大佛和寶蓮禪寺等名勝後，沿途盡覽山巒幽谷的醉人風景。

The Ngong Ping Trail is a must-go route for hiking enthusiasts. It connects popular Lantau tourist spots in Tung Chung and Ngong Ping to form an exciting land tour. Used as the access for maintenance and rescue trail for Ngong Ping 360, the footpath passes through natural attractions such as mountains and valleys, with much of it directly under the path of the cable cars. Visiting Tian Tan Buddha and Po Lin Monastery in Ngong Ping with some spectacular scenery along the way is a joyful experience.

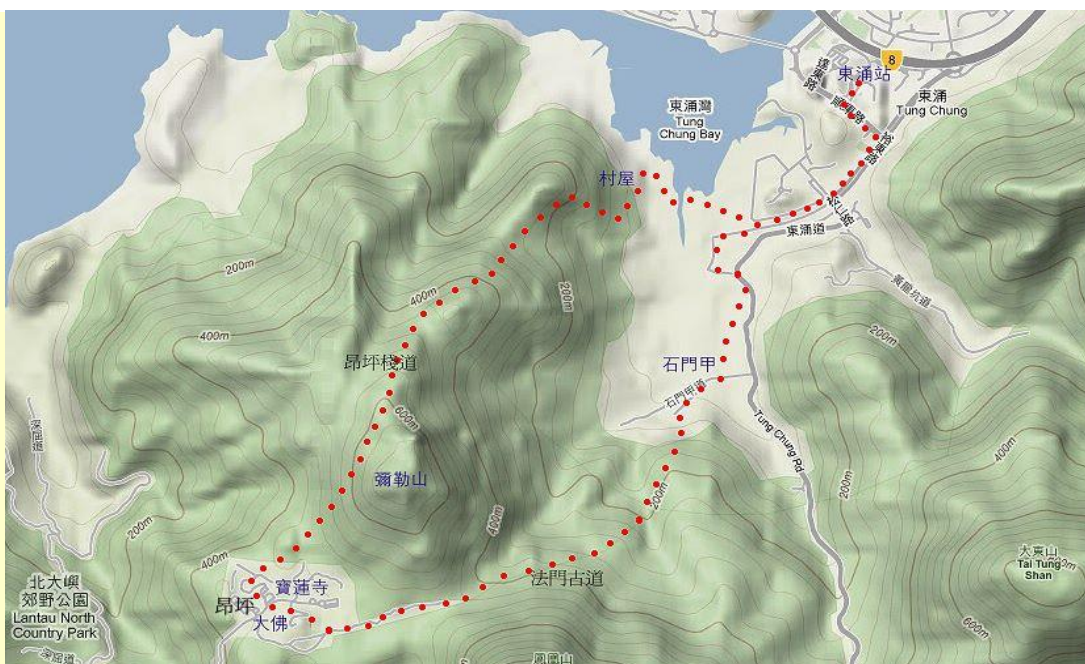
