Description

鶴藪營地位於石坳山之東麓，鄰近鶴藪水塘。而除周圍的美麗景色之外，此地樹木蔽天，百鳥爭鳴，溪流處處，即使是炎炎夏日，也是清爽涼快，暑氣全消。水塘郊遊徑四通八達，可前往沙螺洞或流水響水塘，也可挑戰屏風山及八仙嶺等。

Situated at the northern slope of Shek Au Shan, the site is adjacent to the Hok Tau Reservoir. Apart from its picturesque environment, you are surrounded by luxuriant trees, songs of birds, fresh water stream which keep you cool in hot summer. The site features numerous routes connected with Sha Lo Tung or Lau Shui Heung Reservoir. You may also challenge nearby ranges such as Ping Fung Shan and Pat Sin Leng.
