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谷埔村位於沙頭角海東岸，在鹿頸之北。兩者之間，有小徑可通。小丘高平草短，望對海梧桐山上下及沙頭角海岸南北幽勝，為大隊休憩或野餐好去處。小丘之北，有一條細小村落名“鳳坑村”，亦作“風坑”；村前有小碼頭，村口繞以鐵絲網，對外客規防甚嚴，自鳳坑村沿海而行約三十分鐘，可至“谷埔”。谷埔村環山抱繞。東部在谷口處為高二零一公尺之“石芽頭”；其南為高二九公尺之“尖光峒”。東部之石芽頭群石凌空，尖光峒尖拔而缺，皆多長松蔭護；西部群丘低平緩順，疏松茂草，美態另具。本村由新屋下，一肚、二肚、三肚、四肚、五肚及老圍組成，居民頗眾。“五肚”之南即五肚嶺；老圍以北海面稱“大環”。村西側原有古道直通“烏蛟騰村”，但半道野枝茂草，今已不易通行。谷埔村村谷廣闊而耕地良多，村後有山澗分別下注；居民勤奮、物產豐饒，盛勢多年不減。本村設有公立“啟才學校”，為一完全小學。自谷埔東南古道過古榕後上走，不久古道兩分。從東北去可至分水坳；由此可下“荔枝窩”，或北折“老虎石頂”；或南向越坳上小丘至“阿媽笏”。村中原有細小天后古廟，又有本港罕見之外牆魚形洩水雕飾；然今俱見毀敗，殊為可惜。
