## Description

沿途經過的梅子林村，先祖吳氏三百多年前，從廣東五華縣遷居於此。梅子林北港古徑為該地村民往來西貢至大水坑甚至沙田黃泥頭的重要通道。這古徑至今依然存在，沿途欣賞淒涼廢村的古老痕跡、綿綿不絕的石板路、清朗的高原以及西貢海景。 Mui Tsz Lam is surrounded by the Ma On Shan Country Park. The route starts from Mui Tsz Lam village in Ma On Shan Country Park, where the habitat is dominated by cultivated land and shrub. The route then cuts through a mature woodland before reaching the abandoned village of Mau Ping and beautiful sea view of Sai Kung.

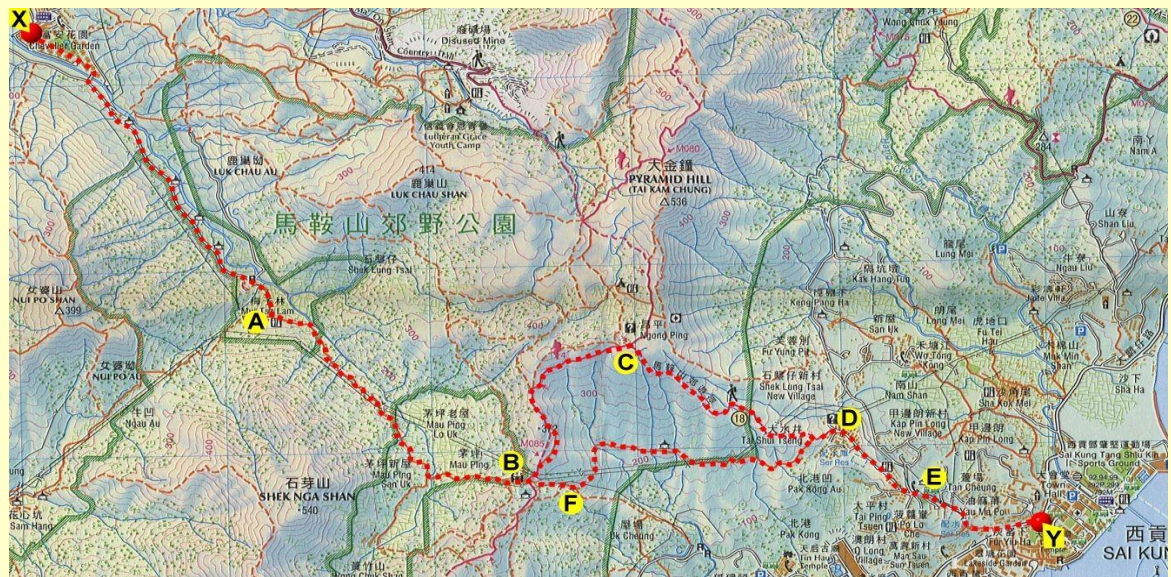
### 起程 Starting Point

1. Bus : 沙田市中心乘85K或86K (亞公角下車步行5分鐘)  
Take route no. 85K or 86K at Shatin Railway Station Bus Terminus  
(Get off at A Kung Kok station, 5 mins walk to gathering point)
2. MTR : 港鐵大圍轉馬鐵至大水坑站 (步行20分鐘)  
Take MTR Ma On Shan Line to Tai Shui Hang Station (20 mins walk to gathering point)
3. Taxi : 港鐵大學站 -> (~ \$30)  
From MTR University Station
